NOTICE OF RACE

1. RULES

- 1.1. The competition will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*, the Prescriptions of the United States Sailing Association and applicable Class Rules unless any of these rules are changed by the Sailing Instructions.

2. ADVERTISING

- 2.1. A boat and her crew shall comply with ISAF Regulation 20, Advertising Code.

3. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 3.1. The competition is open to boats of any class provided they are crewed by two or more persons.
- 3.2. Eligible boats may enter by completing the registration form available on the Saint Croix Sailing Club (SCSC) website and sending it, together with the required fee, to the SCSC Treasurer by 2400 hours on Wednesday, August 29th.
- 3.3. Late entries will be accepted.

4. CLASSIFICATION

Boats will be classified according the SCSC ratings policy. Based on the number of entries submitted by 2400 hours on Wednesday, August 29th, the Organizing Committee will divide the entrants into two (2) divisions based on PHRF handicaps.

5. FEES

The entry fee is \$125 per boat.

6. SCHEDULE

- 6.1. Skippers Meeting: Based on the entries submitted by 2400 hours on Wednesday, August 29th the Organizing Committee will determine if a Skippers meeting will be held. If a skippers meeting is necessary, the meeting will be held on Saturday, September 1st at 0900 hours at the St. Croix Marina Clubhouse
- 6.2. Dates of Racing:
Saturday, September 1st and Sunday, September 2nd
- 6.3. Award Ceremony:
The award ceremony will be held at the St. Croix Marina Clubhouse immediately following racing on Sunday, September 2nd.

6.4. Number of Races:

The regatta consists of a minimum of one race and up to a maximum of eight races. The race committee may schedule up to a maximum of five races per day. Abandoned races may be rescheduled at the discretion of the race committee.

6.5. The scheduled time of the warning signal for the first race for each day is 1100 hours. No race will be scheduled to start after 1500 hours on Sunday, September 2nd.

7. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The Sailing Instructions will be available on the SCSC website no later than 2000 hours on Friday, August 31st.

8. VENUE

8.1. The sailing area will be the Saint Croix River between Stillwater, MN and the Kinnickinnic River, WI. A limited number of transient slips as well as a travel lift are available at the Saint Croix Marina. Several public boat ramps and trailer parking are available in the immediate vicinity of the racing area. 9. THE COURSES

9.1. Diagrams showing the courses, including the approximate angles between legs, the order in which marks are to be passed and the side on which each mark is to be left are available on the SCSC website.

10. PENALTY SYSTEM

10.1. All provisions of RRS Appendix V shall apply.

11. SCORING

11.1. The regatta shall be scored in accordance with RRS Appendix A using the low point scoring system. The provisions of RRS A.2 shall apply.

11.2. There shall be no exclusion of race scores.

12. RADIO COMMUNICATION

Except in an emergency, a boat that is racing shall not make voice or data transmissions and shall not receive voice or data communication that is not available to all boats.

13. PRIZES

Prizes will be awarded to the top three finishers in each division.

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. The Organizing Authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

15. INSURANCE

All boats shall carry adequate liability insurance and provide proof of insurance upon request by the Race Committee.

16. RIGHTS TO USE NAME AND LIKENESS

By participating in this event, competitors automatically grant to the Organizing authority and the event sponsors the right, in perpetuity, to make, use and show, at their discretion, any photography, audit, and video recordings, and other reproductions of them made at the venue or on the water from the time of their arrival at the venue, until their departure, without compensation.
