1 RULES

The competition will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*, the Prescriptions of the United States Sailing Association and applicable Class Rules unless any of these rules are changed by the Sailing Instructions. The event is governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.

.1 A boat and her crew shall comply with ISAF Regulation 20, Advertising Code.

2 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The Sailing Instructions will be available on the SCSC website no later than 1900 hours on Thursday, May 14thprior to the Skippers Meeting. Additional copies of the Sailing Instructions will be available at the Skippers Meeting The date of the Skippers Meeting can be found on the St. Croix Sailing Club (SCSC) website.

3 COMMUNICATION

- 3.1 The online official notice board is located at http://stcroixsailing.com
- 3.2 On the water, the Race Committee will make courtesy broadcasts to competitors on VHF channel 72, except when changed by the SI's or the official notice board. Failure to make broadcasts or failure to hear the broadcasts shall not constitute grounds for granting redress. This changes RRS 62.1(a).
- 3.3 [DP] While racing, except in an emergency, a boat shall not make voice or data transmissions and shall not receive voice or data communication that is not available to all boats.

4 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- **4.1** The <u>competition-event</u> is open to boats of any class provided they are crewed by two or more persons at least one of whom shall be a full member of the SCSC.
- 4.2 The event is open to all boats with a valid handicap assigned per the Handicapping Policy on the SCSC website.
- **4.3** Eligible boats may enter by completing the registration form available on the Saint Croix Sailing Club (SCSC) website and sending it, together with the required fee, to the SCSC Treasurer by 2400 hours on Friday. May 1st.

 To be considered an entry in the event, a boat shall complete all registration requirements and pay all fees.
- **4.6** Late entries will be accepted subject to the following: Any boat having registered late will shall be scored as DNE without a hearing until the entry fee and registration paperwork have been received and reviewed by the club. The boat shall be scored DNE for the first two races. This penalty shall only apply to
