

- Leeward Start and/or Finish Line
 - Start or Finish set up to leeward of race course.
 - May be used occasionally usually for multiple-race events

Note: The nearby leeward mark is not a "mark of the course" when starting or finishing. No need to round it.



S/F line set to leeward of entire course. May be used with any course type.




- Leeward Gate
 - Used in combination with Leeward or Modified Start/Finish line.
 - Competitors must go between marks
 - Round either mark
 - Note: Option for a Starboard Rounding!


Used often in large fleets

Note: These are not "Marks of the course" when starting or finishing.

Leeward Gate




Leeward marks must be passed in the middle. Round one as shown.

New Race Course Diagram – Be sure to take a copy!







- Multiple Races YOY Tuesdays
 - R/C may run multiple races on Tuesday evenings IF:
 - Days are long
 - Winds are excellent
 - Racing expected to end by 9pm
 - Throwouts will be increased by 1 for every 5 extra races held
 - These extra races WILL NOT replace any previously scheduled Thursday make-ups.




R/C Notice to Sailors:

- Keep CLEAR of the racing area unless your Prepatory signal has been made. (if reasonably possible, per RRS 24.1)
 - Do not interfere with other boats currently RACING (their PREP flag is or has been flying). Even if they haven't crossed the start line.
 - You may be protested for infractions
 - If protested, you must take your penalty <u>during</u> the next race. (RRS 64.1)
 - The R/C WILL protest this year!









R/C Notice to Sailors:

- Play nice with the fisherpeople
- They will be out on Tuesdays again
- Give them a wide berth
- R/C will do their best to keep our race area away from fishing areas, but you should be good stewards of the water.







Start Sequences – YOY Weekends

- Same course for all. One Huge trophy for the best overall in each regatta!
 - Breaking Waves, Carlson Classic, Autumnal Equinox
- 1st Start
 - Division 3 (high-phrf)
- 2nd Start
 - Division 1 (low-phrf)
- The R/C also has the option for a single start sequence (all divisions at same time)

Start Sequences – Beercan / Non-YOY

- 1st Start
 - Division 5
 - Division 5 competitors have option to start with their appropriate race fleet, but must choose at their first beercan and remain in that fleet for the entire beercan series. Competitors may also choose a fleet for each individual weekend non-yoy race. In all cases, announce your intentions to the committee boat prior to your start.
- 2nd Start
 - Divisions 1 & 3



Start Sequences - Other

Additional sequences in SI's

• Division Start Order is at R/C's discretion and may change

- Unlikely, but has been done in the past
- Watch for your warning flag
- Keep your VHF radio handy (72)
- Club emails also helpful



Start Sequences

- First warning is at 6:30pm for evening races, 11am for weekend races
 - This will be strictly followed
 - Late boats must start w/in 10 minutes of their starting signal or be scored DNS.
